



Master of Arts Degree Program

The Master of Arts (MA) Degree provides students with an individually designed, multidisciplinary, and academically rigorous program. The MA is a student-centered degree that enhances educational choices for intellectual, professional, and personal growth. The degree is learner-designed and focuses on the achievement of the specific learning objectives and outcomes of each student. It provides a framework for students to plan a course of study unique to their own graduate learning needs. Students, with faculty approval, designate an academic specialization that reflects the individualized course of study included in their Degree Plan.
