



Master of Science in Organization Leadership Degree and Certificate Program

The Master of Science in Organization Leadership is designed to meet the needs of working professionals who require project management skills in addition to leadership and team management skills. The program explores leadership from strategic and tactical perspectives, and examines various interrelated management functions that impact project delivery, including Identification, analysis, and mitigation of project risk. It prepares professionals to identify the management processes required to ensure the project is completed within budget and on schedule. The curriculum is a blend of contemporary management practices that focus on leading people, developing teams, and facilitating change in a global environment.
