

Master of Science in Accounting Degree and Certificate Program

The Master of Science in Accounting program was developed to allow those interested in accounting to broaden and deepen their skills. In addition, the classes may help students meet the "150 Hour Requirement" for the CPA Exam. Classes may also meet requirements for the Certified Management Accountant designation. The degree is a 30 credit hour program with an additional eight foundation courses, which these courses may be waived. Classes are offered both in the classroom and online.
