



## Bachelor of Science in Accounting Degree and Certificate Programs

Accounting is central to effective management of business enterprises and is a key component in the proper functioning of the free market system. The Accounting degree program is designed for students wishing to pursue careers in professional accounting areas. These courses can be applied to meet the requirements to take the CPA exam and become a Certified Public Accountant. This degree prepares students to work for companies ranging in size from sole practitioners to international firms. Opportunities for employment exist in both the private and public sectors.
